InVivo creates a large Agriculture division, with Laurent Martel as Director

The InVivo group is creating a large Agriculture division headed by Laurent Martel, previously managing director of Senalia.

As of 1 October 2014, this division will comprise the activities of seeds, agricultural supplies and services (agro-environment/precision agriculture/decision-making tools), logistics and grain storage.

As part of the Group's 10-year strategic project "InVivo 2025", InVivo is reorganising its activities in three divisions corresponding to its three major areas of expertise: Agriculture, Animal Nutrition and Health, and Retail Distribution and Food.

The Agriculture division will comprise the activities of seeds, agricultural supplies and services (agro-environment/precision agriculture/decision-making tools), logistics and grain storage.

The Agriculture division is being created to improve the services offered to member cooperatives by better coordinating their technical, economic and environmental aspects. This organisational restructuring is in keeping with InVivo's dynamic policy of creating value for the cooperatives, the Group, and the French agricultural industry.

This new division will be headed by Laurent Martel starting 1 October 2014.

Mr Martel, 47, has solid experience in France and abroad in the fields of seeds and biotechnologies, chemical pest control, and storage and grain handling, with management roles in marketing, sales and corporate management.

Before joining InVivo, he was managing director of Senalia, a leading port grain handler in Europe.

Laurent Martel will be a member of the Group's Executive Committee, whose new composition will be:
